### **Course Title**

One-Day Range Safety Officer (RSO) Course - *Specific to the Canmore Nordic Centre Provincial Park Biathlon Range*

Participants must be 18 years of age, have successfully completed a Canadian Firearms Safety Course and possess a valid Non-Restricted Firearms Possession and Acquisition License, (PAL). This is a Biathlon specific course and will not cover any other type of firearms.

A maximum number of 15 individuals may participate in each session.
